**Old Business**

Dog Park – There have been residual issues concerning disposal at the site of the park. The disposal bin there is sometimes absent, and dog owners have been referred to the town public works department for complaints.

Building update – Repair/removal of the basement windows on the driveway side of the building remains to be reviewed by Dave and Moe. Replacement of the rear window next to the back entrance will be reviewed when Dave has determined the cost of materials. David King has offered to contribute to the cost when it is decided.

Property update – The Town completed the first mowing of the property for the season the first week of May. Members were reminded that the plastic shield on the park sign at the Giddings Road entrance must be replaced.

Volunteer recruitment – Members were updated about new volunteers. Ginny has recently contacted potential helpers and offered to share contact information for them with our members.

Yard Sale, May 9 – After discussing the current lack of members available for the sale, as well as the potential for inclement weather, it was determined that the sale would be held indoors only, with the Dollar a Bag section to be held in the warming hut. Setup will be on Friday, May 8, noon-2 p.m. for those available to help.

The business being concluded, the meeting was motioned and adjourned at 6:30 p.m.
